

Standard Mileage Rates By Year

Taxpayers may use the standard mileage rate for business travel purposes (Instead of keeping track of actual expenses).

The standard mileage rate for charitable travel purposes is 14 cents per mile. See Section 170(i). An increased mileage rate equal to 70% of the business rate shown above is available for a vehicle used in Hurricane Katrina relief efforts, effective 8/25/05 - 12/31/06.

The standard mileage rate for medical and moving transportation expenses in 2009 is 24 cents per mile. The standard mileage rate for medical and moving transportation expenses in 2008 is 19 cents per mile (1/1/08 - 6/30/08) and 27 cents (7/1/08 - 12/31/08). The standard mileage rate for medical and moving transportation expenses in 2007 is 20 cents per mile, in 2006 is 18 cents per mile, in 2005 is 15 cents per mile (1/1/05 - 8/31/05) and 22 cents (9/1/05 - 12/31/05), in 2004 - 14 cents per mile, in 2003 - 12 cents per mile, in 2002 is 13 cents per mile, in 2001 is 12 cents per mile, and in 2000 is 10 cents per mile.
